



Immunisation for 4 year old children.

Dear Parent/Guardian,

As you enrol your child into primary school or kindergarten please remember to ensure your child's immunisation is up to date.

The National Immunisation Program Schedule recommends that children are immunised at age 4 years to ensure the best protection against vaccine preventable diseases.

Vaccines due:

Priorix – Measles, Mumps, Rubella and
InfanrixIPV – Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis, Polio

These vaccines are available at your local GP clinic or Local Council public immunisation sessions.

All immunisation records for children up to aged 7 years are forwarded to the Australian Childhood Immunisation Register (ACIR). A copy of these records is required on enrolment in kindergarten and primary school.

Each immunisation session is staffed by two highly trained and experienced immunisation nurses. This enables us to give two injections at once while your child plays a counting game. After vaccination your child receives a lolly (with your consent) and a stamp on their hand.
